

Because of your generosity we have been delivering four boxes of food each month to the Sandusky County Food Pantry and one box to the food pantry at Hayes Memorial United Methodist Church.

SANDUSKY COUNTY SHARE AND CARE recently conducted their annual meeting. Here is a portion of the director's report for 2014:

- Free assistance to 11,067 individuals
- Free clothing to 3,239 children
- Free clothing to 3,563 adults
- Free new pairs of shoes to 72 children
- Free new blankets for 2 people
- Food pantry vouchers for 1,946 people
- Prescriptions to 46 individuals
- Gave out 27 packs of diapers
- Rent/utility assistance to 657 individuals
- Other assistance to 164 individuals
- Total Share and Care funds distriuted....\$23,913.


