**Summer is a time for recreation.** It is also a time for RE-creation, a time to slow down and pay more attention to what God is doing to re-create in God's image our lives, our churches, and our world.

We are looking at the next step in the ongoing evolution of LIFT (Lutherans Involved in Fremont Together - the name used for the cooperation among and between St. John's, Grace, Faith, Trinity, and St. Mark).

So as we serve this God of RE-creation, we know that we MUST change. In fact this change has already begun! 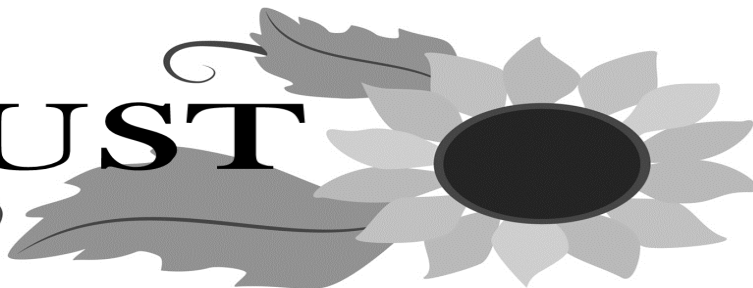
