We recently celebrated another Martin Luther King Day. It is worth noting his words which are continuing to be quoted even 55 years after his passing, "I have a dream!"

It is interesting to note that King had a dream. He did not say that he had a plan...but a dream! I like to plan and have everything in place, but I believe it is more important that we dream. God promises that by the gift of the Holy Spirit, God's people will see visions and dream dreams. We do not find that God will promise to inspire plans.

This is an important distinction as we are beginning our **Dare to Dream** Visioning process. We will begin our **Vision 2025** process this month as we seek to discern living into God's future together.

Unlike many organizations this will not be a strategic plan or long range plan. We will be developing plans on a regular basis, but we will be drafting them in accordance with **Vision 2025**-which will be just what its name implies; a vision. In some ways it will not just be a vision, but a dream.

This will be a vision of what ministry at Grace Lutheran can become-not in the sense of, "oh, they are just dreaming," but in the sense of a longed for vision of what God can use us to be and to do.

This will not be a small vision, and it will not be fulfilled quickly. But month after month, year after year, more of that vision is converted to plans, which then become concrete reality.

Vision 2025 will not be a dream for just anybody-it is a vision of the Kingdom of God breaking through bit by bit at Grace Lutheran Church in Fremont, Ohio. A lot is happening here, and it is not by accident. It is the work of the Holy Spirit coming to fruition through the minds, hearts, commitment and generosity - as well as the dreams and visions - of a faithful people open to being used by God.

You are such a people, and for that I give thanks to God and to you. This is a blessed place and a blessed time.

ALPHA HAS A NEW START DATE! FEBRUARY 9, 2014!!!

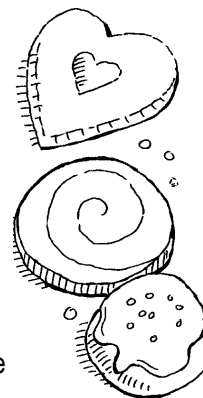
Due to the weather which delayed our original start date, we have had to move the Alpha program back one month. Here is the good news!!! There is more time to sign up!


