Ash Wednesday - CONFESSION - We are called to confess our sins to the Son of David and find forgiveness in him.

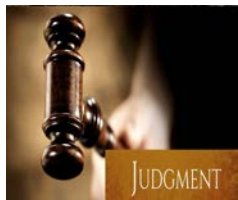
March 8 - BETRAYAL - When we are tempted by Satan to betray our Lord, we gain strength from our Savior to say, "No" to the devil.

Companionship

For over 25 years the Northwestern Ohio Synod has been a companion to the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Tanzania, Dodoma Diocese. NWOS Global Mission Board continues that companionship.



Companionship means accompaniment, walking side by side, “bega qwa bega” working shoulder to shoulder. We at Grace have been “working shoulder to shoulder” with the village of Mzogole, a sub-parish of Iringa Road Lutheran Church, Tanzania, East Africa, through the Mission trips lead by Becky Seibert. Over the past three years Grace members have been part of these trips and contributed to the support of Mzogole by installing cement flooring in the church and distribution of Health kits and School supplies. Christian Mission Outreach at Grace has also supported the Mzogole well project through committee funding and Noisy offering gifts.



Mzogole is fortunate to have a well nearby that is currently being powered by a windmill. Unfortunately, the windmill frequently breaks and the village is then forced to walk a mile to the nearby river bed and dig for water that is then transported by the children twice a day for cooking, drinking and household uses. The ultimate goal is to replace the windmill with a solar-powered pump so the water source will be continuous and the water will be safe to drink. Funds are being raised for this goal through Global Mission Board and we are thankful for the support that Grace has given.

A second project that the village is proposing is to undertake the raising of chickens to help them to be self-supporting by the selling of eggs and chickens for income. This will be overseen by the church at Mzogole and their parent church Iringa Road Lutheran Church.

We ask for your prayers in the support of these projects and our companionship/accompaniment with the village of Mzogole.

QUARTERLY NEWS FROM THE GRACE LUTHERAN ENDOWMENT BOARD

The GLC Endowment Board met January 23, 2017. Fourth quarter 2016 financials were reviewed. The value of the account as of December 31, 2016 was \$1,126,101.99. Based on the Endowment Board's by laws for the amount of money allowable for distribution, \$43,005.89 was available with \$40,850 distributed in 2016. Distribution amount available for 2017 is \$44,531.09. Areas that this money will be distributed to are: Bridge of Hope, LIFT, Share and Care, Liberty Center, Lutheran Home Society, Lutheran Social Services, Pastor Brondos, Senior Dinner, Technology, Bridge of Hope Ministries.

The Endowment Board would like to recognize Hal Hawk for his many years of service to the Board. His service as President of the Board will be greatly missed. This was his last meeting. Thanks Hal.

Mission work for God's Kingdom. Tax deductible contributions from you to the Endowment Fund help the Board accomplish this worthy task. If this appeals to you any Board member or church staff member can direct you on how to participate.
