At the end of May my journey with breast cancer was over! My tumor was removed and my radiation treatments were completed. Yea! It was time to move past a life completely filled with doctor appointments and radiation treatments. I was a cancer survivor! I thought to myself... now I would be able to go back and have that CT scan on my lung. I was supposed to have this earlier, but my surgery took precedence.

My pulmonologist at Cleveland Clinic told me that my lungs look great and I would not need to come back for over a year. She did tell me though...I had one lymph node under my right arm which was enlarged. Just for safety sake, she was going to forward the results to my oncologist. Oh no...my cancer treatments which I had just completed were for my left side and this lymph node was on the right side!!

A scurry of activity ensued. Ultrasounds, biopsies, Cat scans and an MRI. Now here I find myself with primary secondary breast cancer on my right side! But how could this be? It has only been 11 weeks since my first diagnosis?

I began to pray, asking God for strength, healing and peace. As I prayed, I sensed one thing in my spirit: <u>The Lord is faithful</u>. Suddenly my regular schedule and my to-do list did not seem so important.

Last week I thought my life was back to normal. I was back to work, made plans and executed them. Facing cancer again and so soon was not on my to-do list. Today it *is* my list. There is nothing that takes priority, yet life continues to spin around you. Jobs must be completed, meals have to be prepared, errands have to be run, laundry piles up in the hamper, and phone calls need to be returned. All that was before, but cancer and doctor appointments have restructured my day.

But I am a child of God. In Christ I have hope, not fear. I am walking hand in hand with my Lord down a difficult path. I walk with God because I know I can trust God. I know that the Lord will not reject nor neglect me. I know that God alone has the strength I need to face the unknown circumstances of tomorrow. He alone will reach down, gently put His arms around me, and pick me up. He will carry me when I stumble.

No one is in this cancer walk alone. And so, when we are tempted to be overcome with worry because of cancer and its dreadful thoughts, we need to be reminded that we are children of God with all the wonderful promises. We all share in God's grace. I will be forever grateful for a God who loves me and family and friends who continue to support me. Remember, *The Lord is faithful*.


