

### News from the Ark


As we close out the 2021/2022 school year, I just want to thank everyone that has gone above and beyond to make sure this amazing preschool had an awesome year. And, we did! We met so many fun families that we developed friendships with that will hopefully last a lifetime. Each child has a special place in our hearts, and we hope they will also remember their preschool teachers as they move forward in their education. Early Childhood Education is very important because it sets a good foundation for lifelong learning and wellbeing. A great education starts at home but when there is a strong parent/teacher relationship, it can have a positive impact on the child. We really strive for that here at Noah's Ark!

This year, we focused a lot on kindergarten readiness. We first worked on how a classroom works and how it is set up. We also talked and came up with the rules for the classroom. We then moved on to the literacy and language aspects. Not every child develops at the same rate, so we focused on each child individually. We worked on recognizing their name in print, then the letters in their name, and eventually trying to write their names. Every day during our circle time we went over the calendar, shapes, colors, counting and all the letters and their sound. The children this year made big improvements! We performed three assessments throughout the year, so we could keep tract of how the children were progressing. We also had two parent/ teacher conferences, one in November and one in May. At the end of the year conferences, we showed the parents their child's progress throughout the year. Everyone enjoyed seeing where their child began and where they were at the end.

We are very eager to see what the next year brings, and we cannot wait to meet new children and their families. We are happy to announce that this year's 3 year old class will be returning next year! We are very grateful for that bond we have built with those families already and are excited for another year. We are eager to keep working on some changes we are making for this next year and the years to come. We continue to strive and be the best we can be here at Noah's Ark, and we hope everyone that walks through the doors will remember that! Thank you again for all the support we have received!

#### New Marriage, New Church

The year was 1990. Beth and Ed Muffler had discovered in each other the person they wanted to spend the rest of their lives with. So, on July 3, 1993, they tied the knot. Ed was beginning a career in sales, and Beth as a secondary science teacher. Beth and Ed decided that participating in a faith community would be an important way of building their new life together.

Both Beth and Ed had grown up going to church -- Beth's family had attended a Methodist church, and Ed's family a non-denominational church. They decided that they would begin to search for a church and denomination that would be new for both of them.

They didn't have to search long and hard. One day, at school, Beth's teaching colleague, Mindy, asked Beth if she might come with her to Grace Lutheran Church and help with Vacation Bible School. Beth said yes, and helped to lead a section of VBS devoted to a science experiment that taught a spiritual truth.

During that week of Bible School Beth met Grace's pastor Joel Remmers and his wife Kim, two people she instantly connected with. Beth and Ed, and their children, Mike and Emily, began attending Grace regularly, and they all loved it. "It just fit," Beth says. "The more we came, the more people we met, and the more involved we became."

Beth says that in her 22 years of being a part of Grace, she has learned so much about Christ, the Bible, and how it all applies to her life. One of the ways this has happened for Beth at Grace is through her participation in a small group Bible study called SLAM, which is an acronym for Scripture, Life, And Me. Once again, it was Mindy who first invited Beth to come to SLAM.

In this group, members make connections with the Biblical message and each other. "I am most thankful for the relationships that I have formed since coming to Grace," Beth says.

The welcoming spirit of Grace and the generosity of its members make it possible for weekly word and sacrament worship and programs such as VBS and SLAM to continue to provide opportunities for community, learning and fellowship.   - Christ will come again. Should we be worried?




