JUST 4 FUN

The path from 1 to 100

Directions: Draw a pencil line from square 1 to square 100. 

CHURCH COUNCIL - Minutes August 12, 2024

- Call Committee Update: Council met with pastor candidate on August 4. Discussion was held afterwards and unanimous vote was reached to extend a Call. Congregation will have a meet and greet on August 14.
- Congregational Meeting will be held on Sunday, August 25 to vote on the pastor compensation package and to vote on the Call of the pastor. Tom Ritter from the Synod office will be in attendance to assist with the voting process.
- **Build a Bed Project** update event to take place September 13, 2025; Maureen is working with Annette Moore from St. Mark's to work jointly with Grace; the Corn Hole tournament "fun" raiser has been moved to June 22, 2025 to allow for more planning. A Valentine's Day Dinner is also in the planning stages as another "fun" raiser. The cost to build 50 beds is \$10,000.
- **Missions/Outreach:** 3rd quarter Noisy Offering will go to Liberty Center; Usher/Greeter brunch went well; September 1 will begin new Greeter schedule
- Worship: Songs of Summer Hymns series has received positive feedback; on Labor Day weekend worship, congregation is invited to wear what you wear to work; Rally Day is September 8; positive feedback on Courtyard Worship; there were 30 in attendance for Usher/Greeter Brunch.
- **Property:** approved purchase of new ice maker; basement restroom lights have been converted to auto on/off; remote sensor installed in men's bathroom; curbs will be repainted; caution/anti-slip tape will be replaced on exterior steps
- **Stewardship:** Fall Stewardship campaign will begin on November 3 and continue for 4 consecutive Sundays with the theme of "Called to be Faithful".
- Youth: End of Summer Bash attended by 9 youth and 4 adults; canoe trip with the Mufflers scheduled for September 14 at Rest Haven in Castalia; more Fall planning continues.
- **Connecting Kids to Meals** disappointing outcome as no children attended despite staff efforts in advertising on-line, yard signs, electronic sign, and Heather passing out flyers.
