A note from our pastor ...



As we turn the page toward November, we are quickly reminded Thanksgiving is near! When I ponder Thanksgiving, the hymn by Henry Smith entitled "Give Thanks" quickly comes to

mind. It's not in our hymnal, but it has appeared in some of Augsburg's supplemental song books. If you do a quick google search on it, you'll be sure to find it. It sings:

*Give thanks with a grateful heart,
give thanks to the Holy One;
give thanks, because he's given
Jesus Christ, his Son.
And now let the weak say 'I am strong',
let the poor say 'I am rich',
because of what the Lord has done for us.
Give thanks!*

Each of the verses are repeated twice before moving on to the next. It's catchy, and meaningful. It's also a bit of an earworm once you start singing it! While I served in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida (11-16) it was our offering hymn nearly every week, so I know it well. Still, it is a great reminder that we are called to give thanks.

Throughout the month of November, I would encourage you to ponder the many and various ways that we can and will express our thanks and praise to God. In fact, we will celebrate some form of thanksgiving as we gather for worship together nearly every weekend in November. On November 2/3, we gather as a people of faith to recall the saints that have gone before us. Here, we give thanks for the new life that is extended to each and every one of us as we close our eyes only to wake in the likeness of God. On November 16/17, we gather as a people of faith to proclaim Christ as King. Here is a title Jesus never aspired to but is rightfully given as his death, resurrection, and ascension have allotted his place at the throne of God. Then, on November 23/24, we will gather for a "Thanksgiving Weekend." While we don't have worship on Thanksgiving Eve or Thanksgiving Morning, we will pause that weekend to celebrate Thanksgiving a bit early through hymns, music, reflection, and prayer. We may even squeeze in a pie fellowship! There is no doubt that our worship life through November will express our gratitude to God for all that we have, for all that we are, and all that Christ has done for us.

In the midst of it all, we will also embark into some conversations regarding stewardship. While we have plenty of rich festival Sundays throughout the month, nearly every week we'll take time to ponder how we may give with a joyful heart some of what God has given to us. While it may be uncomfortable to think of stewardship, we are challenged to remember that stewardship means more than dollars and cents. Stewardship is about whole-self and how we can give of our time, talents, and treasures. Then, let's not forget that we are to be giving as a sign of thanksgiving as we give thanks to the Holy One!

Dear Grace Family,

At the beginning of October Bishop Beaudoin requested a meeting with me. I had a feeling I knew why he wanted the meeting. The timing was too obvious. Pastor Paul Bailie would be leaving as LIFT pastor, which left St. Mark without pastoral leadership, and Pastor C.J. Bailey had come to Grace. My suspicions were right. Bishop Beaudoin asked me to accept the position of Synod Authorized Minister for St. Mark beginning November 1, 2024.

After praying about this, receiving Pastor Bailey's blessing, and a time of discernment I have accepted the position on a part-time basis. What this means is I will be part-time with St. Mark as their SAM and part-time here at Grace continuing as your Lay Associate Minister. My office will still be at Grace, and I will continue with most of the ministry responsibilities as usual. The biggest change will be weekend worship. I will not be in worship here at Grace as I will be preaching at St. Mark. There is a possibility I will preach at Grace when there is a 5th Sunday as long as it is not a festival day.

I am looking forward to this new journey with great excitement and anxiety. Grace is my home, and you are my family. I love you all and don't see myself ever leaving here completely. But this is an opportunity I never imagined would be possible for me and I know it is where Jesus is leading me.

I ask your prayers as I move into this next phase of ministry. I will be praying for Grace and Pastor Bailey's ministry here. I am excited to see where God is leading all of us!

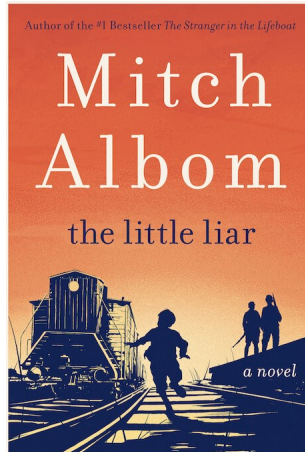

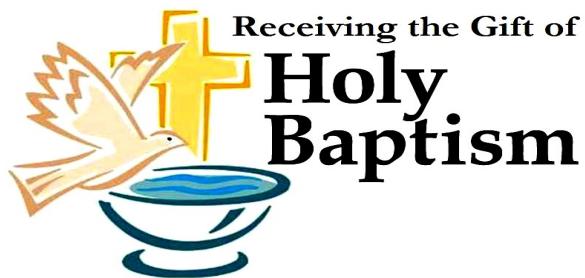

Backpack Program Enters 3rd Year

For a third year, LIFT has partnered with Lutz Elementary School to ensure that their students have access to nutritious food when they are not at school. This year we have 28 families, which includes 95 children. We are seeking donations of kid-friendly food items in individual servings. Especially needed right now are soups, small boxes of cereal, fruit cups/applesauce, and snack crackers. Financial donations can be sent to the LIFT office at Grace Lutheran (705 W. 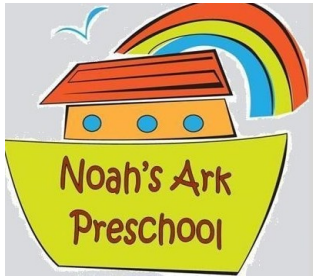
